WHEAT COMPETITION 2016 IN CONJUNCTION WITH

RULES

- 1. ELIGIBILITY. Each club may enter one crop of wheat in to the competition.
- The club is responsible for deciding amongst themselves the crop of wheat that they are going to enter in to the
 competition. Once this is decided the club MUST register their intention to enter with County Office by 28TH
 FEBRUARY 2016.
- 3. Junior Clubs may enter a crop that is not owned by the member or a relative providing that permission has been gained from the landowner and that they are aware that the crop will need to be judged.
- 4. Crops must be a minimum of 4ha (10 acres)
- 5. All crops must be wheat. Any variety is allowed but must be a commercial crop.
- 6. Once the entries have closed a date will be agreed with the judges. This will be given to the clubs.
- 7. When the judges come to look at the crops they will require for the information sheet for the crop to be presented to them.
- 8. The judges will ask a few questions about the management of the crop and reasons for choosing it to enter into the competition. Marks will be awarded accordingly.
