

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1: The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entries.
- 2: Competitors may be disqualified from any class for causing any unnecessary delay to the continuity of the event.
- 3: Entry fees are NOT refundable under any circumstances after the close of entry unless cancelled by the organisers or on presentation of a current Vet's certificate or Doctor's note.
- 4: Objections must be made in writing to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the occurrence or the publishing of results accompanied by a £20 deposit. No video evidence will be considered under any circumstances
- 5: **Legal Liability.** Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, Suffolk Young Farmers Clubs or Easton Farm Park, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, accept any liability for any accident, loss damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other persons or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
- 6: No horses/ponies under 4 years of age allowed to compete.
- 7: **Health and Safety.** The Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all Officials and Stewards.
- 8: **HAT REGULATIONS** – It is mandatory to wear a protective helmet manufactured to one of the minimum standards listed. Hats bearing only the EN1384 or BSEN1384 standard will no longer be accepted under BHS hat rules for 2016. However, hats would be acceptable if they carry EN1384 or BSEN1384 and another standard such as those listed: PAS 015 (1998 or 2011), VG1 01.040 (2014-12), ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards), SNELL E2001, AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards). Hats must be worn when mounted, with chin strap fastened at all times. Hats with long ventilation slits are not allowed for anyone over the age of 9 yrs old. Hats with vertical plastic/metallic strips are permitted.
- 9: No trotting or cantering in public areas - only in designated warm up areas.
- 10: Please ensure dogs are kept on leads at all times.
- 11: Please note: All Horses attending the show should be hand-able, safe & sensible. All riders are responsible for their own Horse & Rider insurance and handling of their animals at all times. Suffolk Young Farmers cannot be held responsible for any liability concerning your horse during the Country Fair.
- 12: No Stallions or mares in foal are permitted to attend

Lead reins permitted and at the discretion of the judge we will allow you to complete the course regardless of faults incurred although these competitors will not go through to the jump off.

Class 5	Pairs Relay—open to horses and ponies	Riders any age	Run over a course of 8 show jumps with the first 4 jumps set at a height of 2ft and the last 4 set at a height of 2ft 6. The first member of each pair will jump the first 4 jumps before handing over to their team member who will complete the final set of 4 jumps. The winning pair will have the quickest combined clear round.

Competitors will be allowed to complete the course at the discretion of the judge regardless of faults incurred but they will not go through to the jump off.
